Dear **NEW JUNIOR TRANSFER** Art Department Students,

Welcome to the Art Department! We look forward to working with you throughout your academic career here and encourage your success in your educational endeavors. Outlined below, you will find information to assist you in preparing for fall quarter and beyond. Hopefully, this will answer some immediate questions about our department and what you might expect over the next few months and into the fall quarter.

**ADVISING:** The Art advisor is here to help you navigate all of the administrative forms, major requirements, and making the most of your time at UCSC. A lot of information can be found at: <http://art.ucsc.edu>, with Advising information on this page: <https://art.ucsc.edu/art-ba-academic-advising>. The Art advisor can be reached by email: [artadvisor@ucsc.edu](mailto:artadvisor@ucsc.edu).

You will be assigned a ladder rank faculty advisor based on your area of emphasis. Faculty are also advisors, but in a different way. Faculty are here to mentor you; to help you with the direction of your work; to give you ideas on what possibilities there are after completing your B.A.; and to help you prepare for your final requirement -- a senior show or comprehensive portfolio review. You need to keep them informed of what you are doing, and to discuss your work, direction, and interests with them. You should meet with a faculty advisor at least once per quarter. Get to know them! You may need to ask for a letter of reference down the line. The email addresses of our faculty members are on our website and are also included later on in this document.

**MAJOR DECLARATION:** As a Junior Transfer who passed the portfolio review in April, you are eligible to be classified as an Art major and will be eligible after Fall to enroll in upper division classes restricted to Art majors **once you complete your major declaration petition in your student portal**. We will go over how to do this at the Fall Welcome Week presentation. You will also need to meet with your college advisor to discuss your general education requirements (if there are any remaining) sometime in the fall quarter.

If you plan to complete a double major or a minor, contact the department you are interested in to find out their procedures and requirements for declaring.

**LOWER DIVISION REQUIREMENTS:** Any 3 of the following, or their equivalent from a previous institution (college or university):

- Art 20G: Introduction to Print Media and Drawing
- Art 20H: Introduction to Sculpture and Public Art
- Art 20I: Introduction to Photography and Digital Media
- Art 20J: Introduction to Drawing and Painting
- Art 20K: Introduction to New Media and Digital Artmaking
- Art 20L: Introduction to Drawing ONLINE CLASS (We will also use AP Drawing Test #14 with a score of 4 or 5 as a lower division studio)

Junior Transfers may have the lower division studio requirements above waived if they have taken equivalent coursework at another institution. In order to enroll in upper division courses that require prerequisites, if the class you took was NOT on ASSIST.ORG, the art advisor needs to code these lower division studios on the Academic Information System (AIS). Please make sure we have all of your transcripts. All prerequisites from the transcripts you submitted for the portfolio review will be coded this summer. However, if you were enrolled in a 2022 spring or summer class, you need to submit a final transcript with final grades to be coded for those prerequisites. If you believe you completed a prerequisite but cannot enroll in a class, contact the art advisor so they can review your file.

**Two Critical Theory and Historical Context courses** - You are required to take two courses from History of Art and Visual Culture—one with a western emphasis (or AP Art History) and one with a non-western emphasis. You may have taken equivalent coursework at your

community college or at another university. If you have AP Art History let the art advisor know. This will fulfill the western Critical Theory requirement.

**REQUIREMENTS:** All junior transfer art students that are following the 2021-22 requirements will be required to take the following courses:

ONE of the Foundation courses (may be taken at a community college):

Art 10E: 3D Foundation **or** Art 10D: 2D Foundation **or** Art 10F: 4D Foundation

**And:**

Art 80T: Digital Tools for Contemporary Art Practice ONLINE CLASS (Winter 2023)

**And:**

Art 190A: Writing for Artists (Winter 2023)

**And:**

Seven upper division studios of your choice.

**And:**

Comprehensive exam

**WAIT LISTS AND "CRASHING" COURSES:** What should you do if you can't enroll in a class because it is filled? First, get on the wait list on your Student Portal. If a space opens up and you have the prerequisites, you will be placed automatically in the class if no one on the list before you meet these requirements. (This is applicable to all courses on campus.) If you don't get enrolled before class starts, make sure you contact the faculty and let them know of your interest in the class. If there is space available, the instructor will give you a permission number that will allow you to enroll in the class. If you can't get into an art class after contacting the instructor, there may be other classes available to take. You can always email the art advisor and they will try to help you.

**CONTACT INFORMATION:** Once you're declared ART, and you have established a UCSC e-mail address, the art advisor will notify you of important deadlines, added classes, visiting artists, exhibitions, scholarships, special events, jobs, etc. We only send information to ucsc.edu accounts. If you only use a non-UCSC account, you must link the two to get our emails. *We do not send to non-UCSC email accounts.* If you need help linking your email accounts, contact ITS (Information and Technology Services at 459-4357 or email [help@ucsc.edu](mailto:help@ucsc.edu)). Please use your Student Portal to keep your address and phone number up to date. We may use your local/cell phone number to contact you so please make sure it is correct on your portal so we can contact you directly. If, after submitting your signed major declaration form you are not receiving regular weekly emails from us, let the advisor know so they can make sure you are on the art department mailing list.

**MATERIAL FEES:** Some of our classes have fees (classes with fees \$100 or more) for materials purchased by the Art Department. A list of classes and fees is posted on the UCSC web site: <https://registrar.ucsc.edu/fees/course-fees/index.html> Students may incur additional costs purchasing individual supplies.

**UCSC PORTAL AND ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT REPORT:** On the Student Portal, you have access to the Academic Advisement Report that will show you all of your general education and major requirements that you have taken, or still need to take. Please utilize this site as it is the most up to date guide to assist you in your academic planning. If you see anything amiss (requirements you thought you had completed but don't show from transfer credit or AP Art History Exam) please let the advisor know so they can resolve the issue.

**ART DEPARTMENT FACEBOOK PAGE:** Be sure that you like, follow and check our Facebook page for opportunities such as grants, scholarships, internships, competitions, information on student and faculty exhibitions and activities, free figure drawing sessions each quarter, and various other art related activities and news.

**STUDENT ART GALLERIES:** We have four venues where you can exhibit your work during the academic year: 1) Eduardo Carrillo Senior Gallery. This gallery is for graduating seniors to exhibit their work for their comprehensive requirement. Placement into the Senior Gallery is conducted via a lottery sent through the art majors email list. 2 & 3) Mini Galleries. These two glass cases in the Art Quad are available to any student at any level to show their work. Both galleries have exhibit timelines of 1 week. 4) Wall Display glass case inside the art administrative offices E-104. Contact our administrative assistant, Jason Greenberg ([jgreenb1@ucsc.edu](mailto:jgreenb1@ucsc.edu)), for more information or sign up in person in the Art Department office.

**PAPER STORE & PHOTO CHECKOUT:** The Art Department's Paper Store is a resource for students to purchase high quality papers and supplies at cost making it easier and less expensive than purchasing from art stores in town. Examples of supplies regularly available are high quality paper for printmaking, photo paper, transparencies, copper plates, silk screens, and various printmaking tools. The paper store is located in G-103 and hours vary each quarter - check the website. The Photo Checkout is a resource for photo students to get access to analog film cameras of various formats as well as digital SLRs and other photography accessories. The photo checkout is in room 121 in the Digital Arts Research Center (DARC) building.

**STUDY ABROAD:** If you think you may want to go on Study Abroad in fall of your senior year, you should contact the Office of International Education / Global Engagement (<https://studyabroad.ucsc.edu/>) the prior fall, as applications are due almost a year in advance. It is a wonderful opportunity to study abroad while obtaining UCSC course credit. You must also contact your college advisor because taking a quarter on University of California Education Abroad Program (UCEAP) in your senior year may break "senior residency" and effect your time to degree. Your college advisor can evaluate that for you.

**ART DEPARTMENT ORIENTATION:** The Art Department has in-person orientation the week school begins. The date for this year's orientation will be Tuesday, September 20, 2022. You will be notified later this summer with more information about this. Most art faculty and staff will attend. The faculty will tell you about their interests and research, the Staff Research Associates will tell you about their areas, and the art advisor will tell you more about the program and answer any questions you may have. It is a great way to begin getting acquainted and get an overview of the Art Department.

**FIRST DAY OF CLASS:** Remember, the first day of class is Thursday, September 22, 2022. If you have not received an email or a message on canvas from your instructor about the first class meeting one hour prior to the meeting time as listed on the schedule of classes then email your instructor directly asking them what you need to do to attend the first class remotely and to confirm when that is.

PLEASE NOTE: Students must complete at least 4 of the 7 required upper division studios from the UCSC Art Department. Art independent study courses cannot be one of these 4 studios. With this in mind, the following substitutions may be made in any combination so that there are no more than 3 upper division studio courses, of the 7 that are required, that are not taken in the Art Department:

Substitutions: Students may substitute a maximum of 3 upper division courses within the art major. This includes classes taken on EAP (Education Abroad), from other departments on campus, from other universities, colleges, or Independent / Field Studies from within the Art Department. All substitutions must have received a grade of "C" or better.

Independent / Field Studies: Students may only use 2 independent / field studies courses towards upper division studio requirements. Students may take more than 2 of these courses, but any in excess of 2 will NOT be used towards major requirements.

Check the website each quarter for the exact days and location.

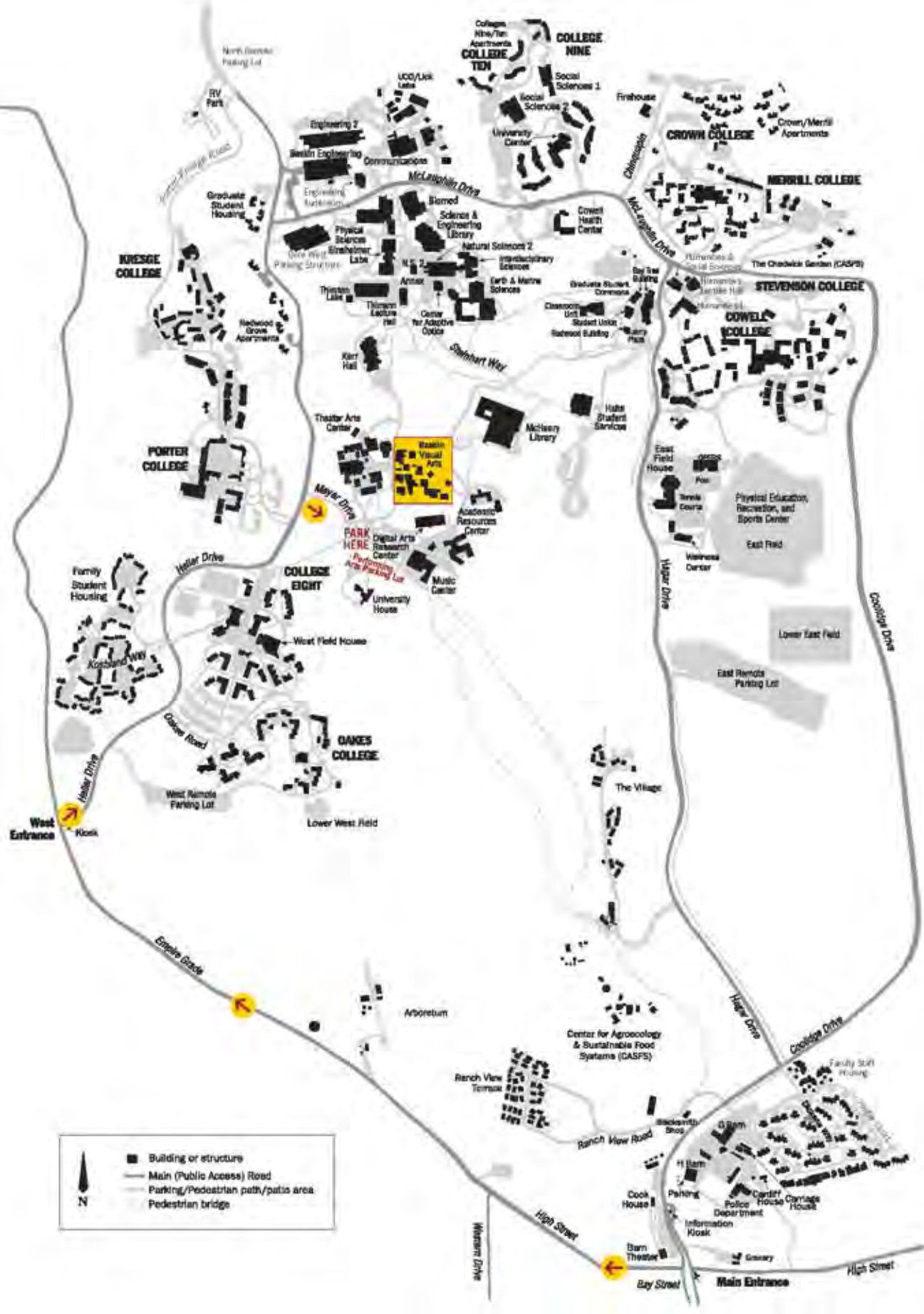
Drop-In Drawing provides a live model and room monitor. There is no formal lesson; the sessions are free and open to the public. (Only during the academic year - not offered in summer)

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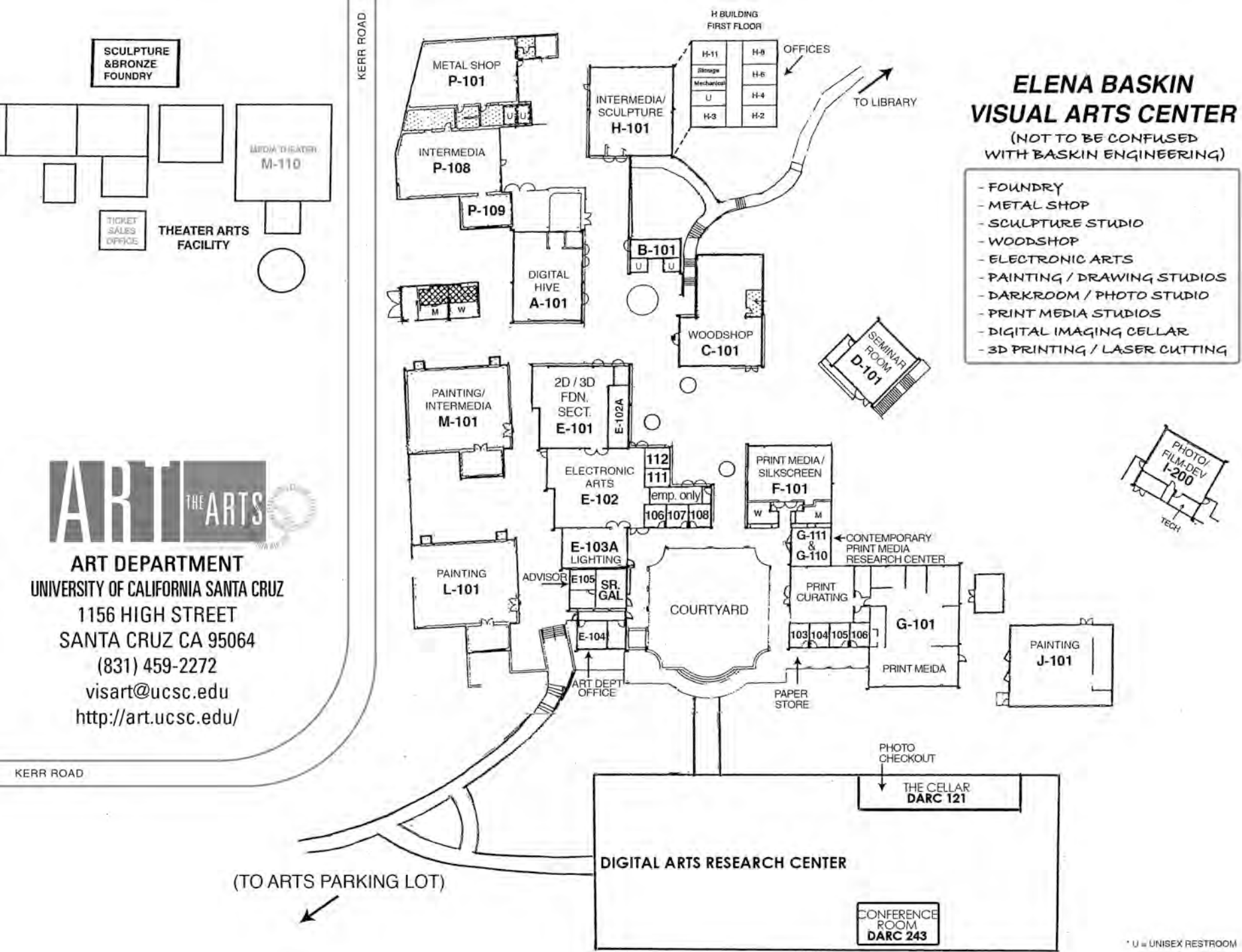
