Paper cut-out demonstrations: Thursday, February 2 @ 2:00-4:00pm,

The Sesnon Gallery is pleased to present a group show that demonstrates the power of cutting by contemporary artists working in the United States. The exhibition exposes a hands-on approach to paper, cutting and an interconnected field of compositions and statements. Kota Ezawa translates his work through a photoshop-like filter using cut colored papers and appropriated images as source material. Lauren Scanlon up-cycles old book pages into the medium and Felicia Gilman implies nesting birds formed through paper constructions. A book of Kara Walker's brings forward the histories of race and American culture with a contrast of black and white pages. In recent years there has been a wave of contemporary artists using paper and cut-out technics as the predominate focus and medium of the work. Recently a comprehensive survey of this movement popped up in New York City, the show was entitled "Slash- paper under the knife."

The Sesnon Gallery encourages interdisciplinary discourse through the lens of the arts. Gallery hours are Tuesday–Saturday noon to 5:00pm. The gallery is located at Porter College, University of California, Santa Cruz and is wheelchair accessible. Admission is free and parking is free on Saturdays.
